

AIM and ICMP Scholarship

Application Form Guidance Notes 2019

Before completing the application form please read these guidance notes.

The AIM and ICMP Scholarship is available to students who meet the academic requirements (found [here](#)) for entry and come from an area of low Higher Education participation, with a household income of below £25,000.

The scholarship covers the tuition fee for one academic year of study on the Cert HE Music Business & Entrepreneurship.

The scholarship does not cover any living costs, travel costs, equipment or reading provision associated with studying on the Cert HE Music Business & Entrepreneurship.

Application to the Scholarship will only be accepted via the relevant [application form](#) and process hitherto.

Satisfactory academic achievement may lead to the opportunity to continue study on the second and third year of the BA Music Business & Entrepreneurship, however the student will be liable for the course fee, in full, should they wish to continue.

Who can apply for the AIM and ICMP Scholarship?

Applicants must meet the following core criteria:

- Have 'Home' funding status. The student finance companies (i.e. Student Finance England, Wales, Northern Ireland or the Student Awards Agency for Scotland) assess residency status. A Home student must have been ordinarily resident in the UK for the three-year period prior to the start of their course
- A household income of less than £25,000. The gross income of all those in your household (e.g. your parents or your partner) before tax and national insurance deductions but minus a few allowable deductions. More information is available from www.gov.uk/student-finance.

Application Deadline

- The closing date for submitting an application is 9th August 2019. We will acknowledge receipt of your application by email within 3 days of receipt.

Decisions:

- Applications will be assessed by an expert panel from ICMP staff and a shortlist of five applicants will be forwarded to AIM who will have the final decision on who they award the Scholarship to.
