Music Production Auditions

ICMP is a supportive and inspirational environment. We always try to keep auditions as informal and fun as possible, while giving you constructive feedback and ensuring that the course that you are hoping to study will be right for you.

The audition process consists of two steps

Firstly, we would like to hear an example of your own creative work. This can be music that you have produced or original music that you have been involved in creating, but it is not limited to these examples.

You could submit a remix, or a reworking of another artists work, or a DJ mix. You can show online examples of your work, such as links on YouTube, Soundcloud, Dropbox, etc. A computer will be available for you to use on the day, please test any links ahead of time.

Secondly, you will be played a piece of music and asked to comment on what you have heard from a production perspective.

The process is relaxed and non-intimidating, you can think of it simply as an opportunity to listen to and discuss music with your prospective tutors.

How to prepare

In preparation for your audition at ICMP, we advise you to review the course details (with module outlines) and programme specification for the course, and select some areas that are of particular interest to you.

Skype Auditions: If you're auditioning remotely via Skype, please ensure that your tracks have been uploaded to an online platform (SoundCloud, YouTube, Spotify, Google Drive, Dropbox, etc). It's important that this is done prior to your audition to avoid delays during the audition.

Ask Questions!

Auditions are your perfect opportunity to ask questions of the tutor, and/or your Admissions Advisor – the audition is as much for us to find out about you, as it is for you to find out about us.
